

Bird list assignment:

Step 1: Go outside

Step 2: Note the time and location you are birding. Note the weather and habitat. When you are done, note how long you birded for.

Step 3: Find at least five species of birds.

Step 4: Write down notes each species (in a notebook or in eBird, either is acceptable). For each species, you must write:

- (1) Why you think it was this species. What field marks did you use? How many individuals did you see?
- (2) Does this species occur in the region and habitat where you saw it? How do you know (Hint, look in your field guide or at eBird)
- (3) Is this the right time of year to see this bird? How do you know? (Hint, look in your field guide or at eBird)
